MC Sask Camp Subcommittee Update

At the MC Sask Annual Delegate Sessions (ADS) in March, 2024, a motion was passed that directs Youth Farm Bible Camp (YFBC) and MC Sask to create an agreement for YFBC to become an independent entity from MC Sask. The motion also states that the independent entity will enter into an agreement with MC Sask for the use of MC Sask land and facilities. This motion was written in consultation with YFBC, as it reflects their wish to be more independent.

How did we get here?

- The motion at the ADS is one step in a process that started in the spring of 2022, when a review of all MC Sask camps began.
- The Mennonite Church Saskatchewan Camps Review Final Report (https://www.mcsask.ca/campstudy) was presented in the spring of 2023.

- Following that report, an MC Sask Council subcommittee was created to work with each camp in potentially redefining their relationship with MC Sask.
- The subcommittee had discussions with board member representatives of each camp which included in-person meetings, email and phone correspondence.
- The motion re: YFBC, as mentioned above, was presented and passed at the ADS in March, 2024.
- Note: At this time, Shekinah Retreat Centre and Camp Elim have not requested any changes to their relationship with MC Sask.

Next steps: The MC Sask Camp Subcommittee will continue to work with YFBC in redefining its relationship with MC Sask.

We (the subcommittee) are thankful for the many discussions we have had over the past two years. We are sincerely appreciative of YFBC's willingness to work collaboratively through this process!
