Prelude

Welcome/Land Appreciation/Announcements/Focus Statement

God's vision of shalom and justice depicts a kingdom in which we radially realign ourselves with the marginalized and oppressed. Who needs to hear the invitation to belong in God's kingdom?

Advent Candle Lighting

- 1: Like a cloth with frayed edges, our world leaves people on the fringes;
- 2: Those who aren't accepted, who don't belong;
- 1: The poor, the brokenhearted, the prisoners, the oppressed.
- 2: But God's kingdom shows us another way.

(Light 3 candles)

All: Give us eyes to notice those on the fringes and arms to extend our boundaries, inviting all to become woven into our communities.

L: Merciful One: you anoint us for justice, you call us to you.

- C: Your Spirit is poured out upon us.
- L: Yours is the way of release and restoration.
- C: May your love flow through us to heal the brokenhearted. May we declare your good news to bring hope to the poor.
- L: You anoint us; we are yours.
- C: We delight and rejoice in you.

These special spaces also give children a place to enhance their English and comprehension skills. During COVID-19 lockdown, the importance of the Children's Peace Library became apparent when the children kept coming to read and learn from the books. They were using the library as an alternative to school so they could keep learning. Books played a key role in helping to bring back hope for the future and to reduce loneliness due to pandemic restrictions. This holiday season, choose a gift that changes lives.
