From the Canadian Mennonite magazine

My favourite theologian died last week. Walter Brueggeman, who was a spiritual father to many, was perhaps best known for his book The Prophetic Imagination, in which he wrote, "The task of prophetic ministry is to nurture, nourish, and evoke a consciousness and perception alternative to the consciousness and perception of the dominant culture around us."

This is not that different from what we try to do with Canadian Mennonite. When we began working on our current feature, we wondered if this was an anti-technology issue. We also heard stories about how Zoom helps people connect when the alternative is isolation. There are compelling reasons for both arguments, but we wanted to go deeper, to examine the massive sea change that digital tech has wrought within our lifetimes, and to nurture the alternative consciousness Brueggeman describes.

We invited readers to a digital detox, examining our technology use and attempting to make room for the Holy Spirit. We think this is a problem for younger people (it is!), but our experimenters found it was equally challenging for older folks—and that it was rewarding too.

This coming weekend is Father's Day. We often reflect on the mixed feelings evoked by Mother's Day, but the same is true for this day. It's my second Father's Day without my dad, and at least one of our kids will be far away. Still, we'll fire up the barbecue.

Walter Brueggeman wrote about fathers and sons, just this year. His loving and thinking were strong to the end.

May we be grateful for those who fathered our lives and faith well and the God who loves us like a good father.
