*Thank you to everyone who came out to the MCC SK Relief Sale this past weekend! The weather was perfect, the food was great and your generosity was amazing. You have helped provide water from the mountains for household use and irrigation for people in Bolivia, provided food security and education on conservation agriculture for those in Haiti and many other essential resources.

Here are some highlights from the MCC Relief Sale:

- -Served approximately 780 meals and raised just over \$31,500 at our food drive through on Saturday
 - -Online auction brought in \$9,929
- -Several MCC Thrift Stores in Saskatchewan donated their sales and had special fundraisers on Friday and Saturday, which generated over \$11,600 for the Relief Sale.
- -Coins are still coming in for My Coins Count and being counted. You can still donate until the end of June (cash and credit card donations are also accepted). These funds will help deaf and blind children in Jordan learn to communicate, learn basic life skills and so much more.
- -The Salebration event brought in \$24,750 so far for the Haiti Agroforestry project. We matched the challenge given to us to raise \$12,000 that evening!! However, you can still give to this great project. All donations are also matched by the government 1:1.
