TODAY'S SCRIPTURES: 1 Samuel 1:20-28 (The Inclusive Bible)

YHWH remembered Hannah. She conceived, and gave birth to a son. She named him Samuel, for she had asked for him.

Elkanah and the whole family made the annual trip to sacrifice to YHWH and make his vows. Hannah did not go, however, telling Elkanah, "Once the child is weaned I will take him up and present him to YHWH in the Tent of Meeting. He will remain there always." Elkanah said, "Do what you think best. Stay here until the child is weaned. For only YHWH may see your vow fulfilled." And she stayed home, nursing the child until she weaned it.

Once weaned, she took the boy with her. She also took a three-year-old bull, an ephah of flour and a skin of wine, and presented him at the Tent of Meeting of YHWH, the God of Israel in Shiloh. After the boy's father sacrificed the young bull, Hannah brought it to Eli, saying, "Sir, as sure as you live, I am the woman who stood here beside you praying to YHWH. I asked YHWH for the boy and God granted my request. Now I give him to YHWH, for his entire life is given to YHWH." And they prostrated themselves there before YHWH.

People even brought their infants forward for Jesus to touch. When the disciples saw this, they scolded the parents. However, Jesus intervened by calling the children to himself. He said, "Let the children come to me. Don't stop them, for the kingdom of heaven belongs to such as these. The truth is, whoever doesn't welcome the kingdom of God like a child will never enter it."
