#### Isaiah 58:6-12

6 On the contrary! This is the sort of fast that pleases me: Remove the chains of injustice! Undo the ropes of the yoke! Let those who are oppressed go free, and break every yoke you encounter! 7 Share your bread with those who are hungry, and shelter homeless poor people!
