TODAY'S SCRIPTURE: Luke 17:11-19 (The Inclusive Bible)

11 On the journey to Jerusalem, Jesus passed along the borders of Samaria and Galilee. 12 As Jesus was entering a village, ten people with leprosy met him. Keeping their distance, 13 they raised their voices and said, "Jesus, Rabbi, have pity on us!" 14 When Jesus saw them, he responded, "Go and show yourselves to the priests." As they were going, they were healed. 15 One of them, realizing what had happened, came back praising God in a loud voice, 16 then fell down at the feet of Jesus and spoke his praises.
