TODAY'S SCRIPTURES: (The Inclusive Bible) 2 Timothy 1:1-7

From Paul, by the will of God an apostle of Christ Jesus, sent to proclaim the promise of life in Christ Jesus, 2 to Timothy, my dear child: may grace, mercy and peace from God the Creator and from Christ Jesus our Savior be with you. 3 I thank God, the God of my ancestors—whom I worship with a clear conscience—whenever I remember you in my prayers, as indeed I do constantly, night and day. 4 When I recall your tears, I long to see you again, which would fill me with joy. 5 I'm reminded of your sincere faith, which first lived in your grandmother Lois, then in your mother Eunice, and now, I'm certain, in you as well. 6 That's why I want to remind you to fan into flame the gift of God, which is in you through the laying on of my hands. 7 For God didn't give us a spirit of timidity, but a spirit of power, of love, of self-discipline.
