Gospel Reading: Luke 6:27-38 (NRSV)

From the Re-opening Committee. As you are aware, Saskatchewan is lifting all COVID restrictions including masking as of the end of February. The public health officials feel this is too quick and the most current statistics appear to be showing that hospitalizations are still very high.
