\*From our Worship Committee regarding the music of David Haas: "The Mennonite Worship and Song Committee responsible for our new hymnal, *Voices Together*, published a press release earlier this summer, noting that songs written by composer David Haas will no longer be included in the hymnal. Accusations of serial sexual misconduct and spiritual manipulation by David Haas came to light earlier this year. Though there may still be merit in the songs themselves, for anyone who pays attention to composers/arrangers, these allegations will surely make them feel uncomfortable with asking a congregation to sing or hear them. David Haas' faith tradition is different from ours, but several of his songs are among our favorites.

Our church Worship Committee urges anyone involved with planning/presenting music in our church to please not use these songs any more:

Sing the Journey #5 Come and be light for our eyes;

Sing the Journey #13 My soul is filled with joy;

Sing the Journey #94 Blest are They;

Sing the Story #16 Peace before us;

Sing the Story #39 Will you come and follow me

Sing the Story #49 I will come to you in the silence

While we have fond memories of singing these songs together and have found them meaningful in the past, we trust that other favorites will fill this gap. There is a lot of good sacred music available to us. We know there may be other composers/arrangers with similar troubles to Mr. Haas', but as a church we can act only on what we know. If you happen to include one of the songs listed above, we trust that you'll accept a nudge from the office secretary, from a member of our Worship Committee or pastoral staff, asking you to switch to a different song."
