Matthew 6:5-15 (The Inclusive Bible) The Lord's Prayer

- 5 "And when you pray, don't behave like the hypocrites; they love to pray standing up in the synagogues and on street corners for people to see them. The truth is, they have received their reward in full. 6 But when you pray, go to your room, shut the door, and pray to God who is in that secret place, and your Abba God—who sees all that is done in secret—will reward you. 7 "And when you pray, don't babble like the Gentiles. They think God will hear them if they use a lot of words. 8 Don't imitate them. Your God knows what you need before you ask it.
 - 9 This is how you are to pray: 'Abba God in heaven, hallowed be your name!
- 10 May your reign come; may your will be done on earth as it is in heaven:
- 11 Give us today the bread of Tomorrow.
- 12 And forgive us our debts, as we hereby forgive those who are indebted to us.
- 13 Don't put us to the test, but free us from evil.'
- 14 "If you forgive the faults of others, Abba God will forgive you yours. 15 If you don't forgive others, neither will Abba God forgive you.

Matthew 5:13-15 Salt and Light

- 13 You are the salt of the earth. But what if salt were to lose its flavor? How could you restore it? It would be fit for nothing but to be thrown out and trampled underfoot.
- 14 You are the light of the world. You don't build a city on a hill, then try to hide it, do you? 15 You don't light a lamp, then put it under a bushel basket, do you? No, you set it on a stand where it gives light to all in the house. 16 In the same way, your light must shine before others so that they may see your good acts and give praise to your Abba God in heaven.
