Hi all. For those who could not attend the Semi Annual meeting on June 20, here is some background. On June 19, we had 8 additional people in church for the taping of the service. The re-open committee has set up a configuration of seating to keep people 2M apart and all attending MUST wear masks. After the taping we had a discussion with both the worship team and the re-open committee. The result is that we are going to add additional people slowly starting with an additional 10 people for the taping Saturday, July 4. This is above the 6-8 people who are not able to watch on Facebook. They would be allowed at each taping. Loretta will keep a list of all who want to attend. The first 10 who call or email with all the names in their group will be invited for the July 4th taping. After that taping, the next 10 on the list would be invited for the next taping. The list would grow as more asked to attend and Loretta would simply take the next 10 and when she reached the bottom of the list, take the rest from the top of the list. So to get your names on the list please phone or email Loretta. She will contact you the Wednesday before the taping/service to see if you want to come. This is necessary because the ushers need to have a list of all who are attending and check off the names when they arrive. I am not sure how long this will be required but until we all can attend as we once did, we will try to design ways to keep people physically apart and safe and slowly increase the numbers that can attend.
