We've come to worship God, who loved us before we were yet born, who knows us even better than we know ourselves, whose presence never leaves us, and whose love for us never ceases. This is our God.



# Scripture Reading: Jeremiah 31:1-3; 31-34

The word of YHWH came to Jeremiah and said, "Thus says YHWH, the God of Israel: Write in a book all the words I dictated to you. For the time is coming, says YHWH, when I will restore the fortunes of my people, Judah and Israel, says YHWH, and I will bring them back to take possession of the land I gave their ancestors." # **Scripture Reading** *Matthew* 14:22-27

Jesus insisted that the disciples get into the boat and precede him to the other side. Having sent the crowds away, he went up on the mountain by himself to pray, remaining there alone as night fell. Meanwhile the boat, already a thousand yards from shore, was being tossed about in the waves which had been raised by the fierce winds. At about three in the morning, Jesus came walking toward them on the lake. When the disciples saw Jesus walking on the water, they were terrified. "It is a ghost!" they said, and in their fear they began to cry out. Jesus hastened to reassure them: "Don't worry, it's me! Don't be afraid!" *Ephesians 2:11-18* 


Bear in mind that at one time the men among you who were Gentiles physically—called "the Uncircumcised" by those who call themselves "the Circumcised," all because of a minor operation—had no part in Christ and were excluded from the community of Israel. You were strangers to the Covenant and its promise; you were without hope and without God in the world. But now in Christ Jesus, you who once were far off have been brought near by the blood of Christ. For Christ is our peace, who made both groups into one and broke down the barrier of hostility that kept us apart. In his own flesh, Christ abolished the Law, with its commands and ordinances, in order to make the two into one new person, thus establishing peace and reconciling us all to God in one body through the cross, which put to death the enmity between us. Christ came and "announced the Good News of peace to you who were far away, and to those who were near"; for through Christ, we all have access in one Spirit to our God.


