MC Sask Announces Youth Minister Resignation Mennonite Church Saskatchewan announced today that Kirsten Hamm-Epp has officially resigned from her position as Youth Minister, effective August 31, 2024. "My time with MC Sask has been incredibly live-giving, and it is with a deep sense of gratitude and many, many fond memories that I have come to the decision that it is time for me to move on... It has been a true honour to serve MC Sask for the past eleven years, and I am grateful to have been able to both serve and be mentored by such an incredible 'cloud of witnesses' (Hebrews 12)."

While Hamm-Epp served MC Sask in a variety of roles during her 11year tenure, youth ministry was always at the heart of her role, with major highlights being the annual retreats and hosting/planning the 2019 MC Canada Youth Gathering, Shake. MC Sask is grateful for the energy, integrity, and commitment she brought to her work, and the ways she instilled this spirit into our wider church family as well. We wish her well in this next season of life.

William Janzen, C.M.

Ottawa, Ontario

For over 30 year, William Janzen served as director of the Ottawa Office of the Mennonite Central Committee Canada. He has influenced government policy development and made contributions to refugee resettlement, citizenship, development aid and peace building. He was instrumental in the creation of the Private Sponsorship of Refugees program, mobilizing Canadians to support incoming refugees, notably from Southeast Asia, thus marking a turning point in Canada's immigration policy. **Moving time** is coming for Frieda from Osler home into her new village away from Osler to Bethany Manor.
