Old Testament Reading: Isaiah 1:10-18

Hear the word of YHWH, you rulers of "Sodom"! Listen to the command of YHWH, you people of "Gomorrah": "These interminable sacrifices of yours: what are they to me?" says YHWH. "I am fed up with burnt offerings of rams and the fat of calves! The blood of bulls, lambs, and goats nauseates me. When you came to present yourselves before me, who asked you to trample over my courts? Don't bring any more of your useless offerings to me - their incense fills me with loathing. New moons, Sabbaths, assemblies - I cannot endure another festival of injustice! Your new moons and your pilgrimages I despise with all my soul. They are wearisome to me; I am tired of bearing them.
