
Easter Sunday Deep in the Feast: Called to Deep Living

Gospel Reading: Mark 16:1-8



They were very frightened, but the youth reassured them: "Do not be amazed! You are looking for Jesus of Nazareth, the One who was crucified. He has risen; he is not here. See the place where they laid him. Now go and tell the disciples and Peter, 'Jesus is going ahead of you to Galilee, where you will see him just as he told you."" They made their way out and fled from the tomb bewildered and trembling; but they said nothing to anyone, because they were so afraid.
