Call to Worship (from Psalm 19)

One: The heavens are telling the glory of God; and the firmament proclaims God's handiwork.

Many: Day to day pours forth speech, and night to night declares knowledge.

One: There is no speech . . . yet the voice goes out through all the earth, and their words to the end of the world.

Many: In the heavens you set a tent for the sun. . .. Its rising is from the end of the

heavens, its circuit to the end of them; nothing is hid from its heat.

One: The law of the Lord is perfect . . . sure . . . clear . . . true and righteous.


The fear of the Lord is pure.

Gospel Reading: John 2:13-22

Since it was almost the Jewish Passover, Jesus went up to Jerusalem. 14 In the Temple, he found people selling cattle, sheep and pigeons, while moneychangers sat at their counters. 15 Making a whip out of cords, Jesus drove them all out of the Temple—even the cattle and sheep—and overturned the tables of the money changers, scattering their coins. 16 Then he faced the pigeon sellers: "Take all this out of here! Stop turning God's house into a market!" 17 The disciples remembered the words of scripture: "Zeal for your house consumes me." 18 The Temple authorities intervened and said, "What sign can you show us to justify what you've done?" 19 Jesus answered, "Destroy this temple, and in three days I will raise it up." 20 They retorted, "It has taken forty-six years to build this Temple, and you're going to raise it up in three days?" 21 But the temple he was speaking of was his body. 22 It was only after Jesus had been raised from the dead that the disciples remembered this statement and believed the scripture—and the words that Jesus had spoken.

Prayer of Confession and Assurance

One: We confess when we have settled into sameness, forgetting the rhythms of the heavens,


ignoring the rhythms of justice. We confess when we have not looked up into the eyes of a neighbour, into your Word that still lives.

Many: Calling us to deep wisdom. We come to you, God.

Epistle Reading: 1 Corinthians 1:18-25

18 For the message of the cross is complete absurdity to those who are headed for ruin, but to us who are experiencing salvation, it is the power of God. 19 Scripture says, "I will destroy the wisdom of the wise and thwart the learning of the learned." 20 Where are the wise? Where are the scholars? Where are the philosophers of this age? Has not God turned the wisdom of this world into folly? 21 If it was God's wisdom that the world in its wisdom would not know God, it was because God wanted to save those who have faith through the foolishness of the message we preach. 22 For while the Jews call for miracles and the Greeks look for wisdom, 23 here we are

preaching a Messiah nailed to a cross. To the Jews this is an obstacle they cannot get over, and to the Greeks it is madness—24 but to those who have been called, whether they are Jews or Greeks, Christ is the power and the wisdom of God. 25 For God's foolishness is wiser than human wisdom, and God's weakness is stronger than human strength.




