#### \*An Urgent prayer request from Mennonite Church Canada:

Dear Partners in prayer:

Siaka Traoré, leader of the Mennonite Church in Burkina Faso, invites prayer support for leadership and members of the small church plant in Sidi, a small farming community. Earlier this year, landowners demanded that each farmer provide an offering for the spirits believed to watch over the fields. As a matter of faith, Sidi church members refused to do so. Siaka reports that the village chief's son just issued an ultimatum: Christians must leave the village by January 31, 2015 and destroy the church building in which they gather so that the mayor's office can begin a new building project in its place. Death threats have been issued for those who refuse to comply. Siaka also says the land the church is located on was given to the Christians by the entire village. The building is less than one year old. A mediator who has a relationship with the chief's family has been called in to negotiate on behalf of the church. Please pray for the continuing faithfulness of the Sidi church and wise council from the mediator. Pray that God's presence, grace and love will be revealed to the chief's son and family, and that reason and peace will prevail.
