## **T|ODAY'S SCRIPTURE LESSONS:**

### John 15: 14-27

<sup>14</sup>You are my friends if you do what I command you. <sup>15</sup>I do not call you servants any longer, because the servant does not know what the master is doing; but I have called you friends, because I have made known to you everything that I have heard from my Father. <sup>16</sup>You did not choose me but I chose you. And I appointed you to go and bear fruit, fruit that will last, so that the Father will give you whatever you ask him in my name. <sup>17</sup>I am giving you these commands so that you may love one another.

18 'If the world hates you, be aware that it hated me before it hated you.<sup>19</sup>If you belonged to the world, the world would love you as its own. Because you do not belong to the world, but I have chosen you out of the world—therefore the world hates you.<sup>20</sup>Remember the word that I said to you, "Servants are not greater than their master." If they persecuted me, they will persecute you; if they kept my word, they will keep yours also.<sup>21</sup>But they will do all these things to you on account of my name, because they do not know him who sent me.<sup>22</sup>If I had not come and spoken to them, they would not have sin; but now they have no excuse for their sin.<sup>23</sup>Whoever hates me hates my Father also.<sup>24</sup>If I had not done among them the works that no one else did, they would not have sin. But now they have seen and hated both me and my Father.<sup>25</sup>It was to fulfil the word that is written in their law, "They hated me without a cause."

26 'When the Advocate comes, whom I will send to you from the Father, the Spirit of truth who comes from the Father, he will testify on my behalf.<sup>27</sup>You also are to testify because you have been with me from the beginning.
