

"I held your pain – a small part of your pain – for a day and it hurt me, it moved me, it changed me."

Jennifer Henry shared these words from Imam Michael Taylor, an honorary witness to the Canadian Truth and Reconciliation Commission, in the first installment of the 5 part *Intotemak** series, "Decolonizing our Hearts."

Henry, the Executive Director of Kairos Canada, says we have to "decolonize our hearts" and make room to hear the truth – what Cree people call "heart speaking" – about colonialism and the Indigenous experience before true reconciliation can occur.

Residential School Survivors' stories are now part of the public record and TRC Commissioners shared their final report in Ottawa on June 3. They offered a list of recommendations, including some for the church. They invited an apology from Pope Francis; the development of educational strategies and curriculums for leaders and congregations; and the establishment of permanent funding for community controlled healing and reconciliation projects, culture and language restoration projects, education and relationship building, and youth dialogue with Indigenous leaders.
