Various news agencies report that an explosion in a busy night market in Davao City, Philippines has left at least 14 people dead and dozens injured. Davao is home to Witness workers Dann and Joji Pantoja, their ministry partners Peacebuilders Community, and Coffee for Peace. The market was subsequently closed to the public and people were sent home. Although the cause of the explosion is not yet known, some reports say it may have been an assassination attempt on Philippine president, Rodrigo Duterte, whose extreme hardline responses to those involved in the illegal drug industry are being questioned.
