Ride for Refuge

Mission & Service committee is building a connection with Nathan and Taryn Dirks, MC Canada witness workers in Botswana (see <u>http://ntdirks.com</u>). Nathan and Taryn work with indigenous churches in Gabarone, with a focus on outreach to prisoners and to young people.

Their latest project is to construct outdoor soccer pitches, to a Brazilian design (sports geeks can check the concept at <u>https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Futsal</u>), as part of their programme for young people - many of whom are currently instead gravitating towards the bars and getting into trouble. This will require funding - so MC Canada is participating in a nationally organised fundraising sponsored cycling event, Ride for Refuge, on Saturday October 4th this year. Osler is entering a team - currently consisting of Mark Bigland-Pritchard and Stephanie Siemens, though there is room for more.
